ROLL CALL

The roll was called showing all members present except Mr. Davis (Portage), Mr. Gott (Livonia) and Mrs. Erdle (West Sparta).

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The County Administrator introduced United States Marine Corps Veteran, Corporal Adam Bruce Pritchard:

Corporal Adam Bruce Pritchard was born in Dansville, NY and a 2006 graduate of Keshequa High School in Nunda. He attended and graduated from the Building Trades Program from the Genesee Valley Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) and went on to serve in the United States Marine Corps from September 24, 2006 until his honorable discharge on October 18, 2014. Corporal Pritchard started his basic training at Marine Corps Recruit Depot at Parris Island in Port Royal, South Carolina. He continued his military training at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and was a Certified Engineer Equipment Mechanic. His additional training was in Civil Affairs and Construction Equipment Repair. His duty stations include Okinawa, Japan while also conducting training exercises in the Philippines. Adam continued his service with the 10th Marines at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina before serving in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan from December 2011 to May of 2012. Upon his return from overseas service Adam completed the remainder of his military service at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina. For his military service, Corporal Pritchard received The Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal; The Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; The Navy Meritorious Unit Commendation; The Afghanistan Campaign Medal with 1 Star; The NATO Medal-I.S.A.F. Afghanistan; The National Defense Service Medal; The Sea Service Deployment Ribbon as well as the Expert Rifle and Pistol Qualification badges.

Upon returning home, Adam went back To Genesee Valley BOCES completing his Class A CDL License. He worked construction with a family business and as a driver for GT Logistics out of Wayland. He has spent the last five years as a driver with Nunda Lumber where he continues to work today. Adam is involved in his local community as a member the Nunda VFW Post 8961 and Nunda American Legion Post 333, where he serves as their Finance Officer. His hobbies include being outdoors, hunting, fishing, and playing golf. He resides in Nunda with his wife Alicia and their three children.

Corporal Adam Bruce Pritchard led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The County Administrator and Chairman LeFeber, on behalf of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors, presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Corporal Adam Bruce Pritchard. The audience presented a standing ovation.

MOMENT OF SILENCE

Chairman LeFeber requested a moment of silence for Tara Schramm, who passed away recently. Tara was an employee of the Department of Social Services over the last year and before that was an employee of the Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of 10/26/22 Regular Meeting were approved as presented.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. LOCAL LAW NO. C-2022 OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR LIVINGSTON COUNTY FOR THE 2023 FISCAL YEAR

Chairman LeFeber asked Ian Coyle to comment on the local law.

The County Administrator explained that Local Law C overrides the tax levy limit of the County. In 2012 the New York State Law changed with respect to finance tax and County law which prevented counties from go up beyond the

New York State imposed limits of 2%. This is never really 2%, sometimes it has been 2% sometimes it has been 2-3%. In this case the County, for the first time, is proposing a budget that overrides the levy limit. Basically, the levy limit is about \$500,000 short of what we think we need to raise the taxes in the terms of the total levy. The total levy is about \$3.8 Million. The State is telling us \$30.2-\$30.3 is our levy limitation. The Board can override that with a 60% vote of the Board of Supervisors. Up for consideration later today, prior to the budget consideration, is passage of the override vote.

2. LOCAL LAW D-2022 UPDATING APPORTIONMENT FOR THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON A WEIGHTED VOTE BASIS

Chairman LeFeber asked Shannon Hillier to comment on the local law.

The County Attorney explained that Local Law D-2022 implements an adjusted weighted vote plan for the Livingston County Board of Supervisors based on the population count of the 2020 Census. Said plan was created in consultation with the Center for Governmental Research and provides the fairest distribution of voting power among Board members.

3. PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS OF LIVINGSTON COUNTY AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT 2

Chairman LeFeber asked Angela Ellis to comment on the proposed modifications to Ag District 2.

Angela Ellis explained that effective September 17, 2004, the New York State Agricultural and Markets Law was amended with Section 303-b, which allows for parcels to be added into Agricultural Districts on an annual basis. The Livingston County Board of Supervisors designated the month of September as the thirty-day annual period for submission of petitions by landowners to join an existing Agricultural District. One petition for inclusion of predominantly viable agricultural land within a certified agricultural district was filed with the Livingston County Board of Supervisors this year. Pursuant to NYS Agricultural and Markets Law, the County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board conducted its review of the petitions on October 20, 2022, and determined that 2 parcels proposed for inclusion in the agricultural districts consist predominately of viable agricultural land, and that the inclusion of such land would serve the public interest by assisting in maintaining a viable agricultural industry within the agricultural districts. These parcels comprise approximately 113.44 acres and are located in the Town of Conesus. Today's public hearing is to allow public comment on the consideration of these petitions to modify Livingston County Agricultural District #2, and to comment on the recommendation of the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board.

4. PROPOSED LIVINGSTON COUNTY BUDGET FOR 2023 PURSUANT TO SECTION 359 OF COUNTY LAW – PRESENTATION BY COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR IAN M. COYLE

Chairman LeFeber asked Ian Coyle to comment on the proposed 2023 budget.

County Administrator Ian Coyle gave an overview of the proposed 2023 budget.

Chairman LeFeber declared the public hearings open and stated anyone from the public interested in speaking to please come forward and sign in at the podium. No one wished to speak. The Chairman asked if any Supervisor wished to comment. The Chairman announced that the public hearings would remain open until the end of the meeting.

INTRODUCTION OF LOCAL LAW

1. LOCAL LAW NO. E-2022 PROVIDING A PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAXES TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES WHO HAVE LIMITED INCOME

Chairman LeFeber asked the Bill Fuller to comment on the local laws. Real Property Tax Services Director reviewed the local laws for introduction.

Local Law No. E-2022 "Providing a Partial Exemption from Real Property Taxes to Persons with Disabilities who have Limited Income". On August 8th, the Governor signed legislation to increase the income limit of the 50% exemption for both the "Persons with Disabilities who have Limited Income" and the "Senior Citizen" exemptions from \$29,000 to \$50,000. Local Law No. E-2022 would increase our current income limit of \$20,000 to \$28,000 for the 50% exemption and it would increase our maximum income limit of \$28,399.99 to \$36,399.99 for the 5% exemption

per the sliding scale provided in Real Property Tax Law Section 459-c.

2. LOCAL LAW NO. F-2022 PROVIDING A PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAXES TO CERTAIN ELIGIBLE SENIOR CITIZENS

Real Property Tax Services Director introduced Local Law No. F-2022 “Providing a Partial Exemption from Real Property Taxes to Certain Eligible Senior Citizens”.

This Local Law would provide the same income limits of \$28,000-\$36,399.99 for the Senior Citizens exemption per the sliding scale in Real Property Tax Law Section 467. The proposed income limits were determined by using the Cost of Living Adjustments for Social Security benefits from 2014 thru 2023, which are calculated by using the Consumer Price Index. The proposed new income limits represent a 28% increase in the maximum allowable income. Our Neighboring Counties-Maximum Income are as follows: Allegany - \$19,500 no change; Genesee - \$24,900 no change; Monroe - \$50,000 new limit; Ontario - \$21,200 no change; Steuben - \$38,399.99 new limit; Wyoming - \$24,400 no change.

OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR LIVINGSTON COUNTY FOR THE 2023 FISCAL YEAR

Be it enacted by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by Livingston County pursuant to New York State General Municipal Law Section 3-c, and to allow Livingston County to adopt a budget for the 2023 fiscal year that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law Section 3-c.

Section 2. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Livingston County Board of Supervisors hereby overrides the tax levy limit for Livingston County for the 2023 fiscal year and authorizes Livingston County, after completing all required procedures for the adoption of a budget, to adopt a budget for 2023 that requires a real property tax levy greater than the tax levy limit otherwise prescribed by Section 3-c of the General Municipal Law.

Section 3. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law Section 3-c, which expressly authorizes the Livingston County Board of Supervisors to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Board.

Section 4. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately.

UPDATING APPORTIONMENT FOR THE LIVINGSTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON A WEIGHTED VOTE BASIS

Be it enacted by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. The Livingston County Board of Supervisors having heretofore enacted local laws implementing adjusted weighted voting plans for simple majority and two-thirds majority votes, and since those enactments the 2020 Federal census has been completed, the Livingston County Board of Supervisors has prepared revised plans utilizing said census figures.

Section 2. The apportionment of the voting strength of each of the members of the Livingston County Board of Supervisors as determined by utilization of the 2020 Federal census shall be as follows upon any vote requiring a simple majority vote:

Section 4. Any local law, ordinance, resolution or other act to the extent inconsistent herewith shall be superseded by this Local Law.

Section 5. If any clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph or section thereof directly involved in the preceding in which such adjudication shall have rendered.

Section 6. This Local Law shall become effective upon the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum.
