LOCAL LAW NO. 1, 1972, COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES
FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the County Judge and Surrogate and Family Court Judge shall be increased by \$1,475.

Section 2. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salaries of the two (2) Commissioners of Elections shall be increased by \$236. each.

Section 3. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased by \$615.

Section 4. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be increased by \$1,149.

Section 5. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the three (3) Commissioners of Civil Service shall be increased by \$23. each.

Section 6. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the Indigent Defendant Administrator shall be increased by \$54.


Section 7. Effective as hereinafter provided, the annual salary of the County Treasurer shall be increased by \$1,149.

Section 8. All salaries set forth herein shall be retroactive to January 1, 1972.

Section 9. This Local Law shall take effect on the date of filing in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
