LIVINGSTON COUNTY NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 2 - 2016

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON TO SELL .546 ACRES ON BANK STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF DANSVILLE BY PRIVATE SALES

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Supervisors of Livingston County intend by this local law to supercede the provisions of County Law § 215 (5) and § 215 (6), which limits sales of County real property to the highest responsible bidder after public advertisement. The County of Livingston acquired 7 Bank Street, Dansville, New York (former Wilcox Press property) by tax foreclosure and had the property remediated with the assistance of a New York State grant. Three adjoining landowners and the Village of Dansville have requested small parcels from the County to clear up boundary and encroachment issues and to provide additional parking for the Village park. The County of Livingston elects to supercede the provisions of County Law § 215 (5) and § 215 (6) and allow the private sales of these parcels.

- Section 2: The County of Livingston, by resolution adopted January 13, 2016, declared 4 small parcels (.546) located within the 7 Bank Street parcel in the Village of Dansville to be surplus property.
- Section 3: The County of Livingston is hereby authorized to sell said parcels to the following persons at the price set forth herein:
 - a. Tricia Anne Guerin, .359 acres, \$3,493.93;
 - b. Virginia C. VanWinkle, .074 acres, \$743.13;
 - c. James and Susan Jackson, .046 acres, \$350.00;
 - d. The Village of Dansville, .077 acres, \$1,000.00.
- Section 4: This local law is subject to a permissive referendum.
- Section 5: This local law shall take effect on the date of filing with the Secretary of State of New York.
