After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following case was handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on January 10, 2017.

NATASHA A. BOUTON, age 45, of Cameron Mills pled guilty to Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017 for sentencing.

ERIC R. BRUMSTED, age 55, of East Bethany was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.

DAWN N. DIPILATO, age 34, of Honeoye admitted a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to January 31, 2017.

CHASE J. FRANCIS-WHIPSET, age 27, of Caledonia was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding. He was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 31, 2017.

RICHARD W. FRANKLIN, age 33, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 64 hours community service. He was ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution of \$14,667.93.

AMIE M. GOMOLL, age 34, of Conesus pled guilty to Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and admitted a violation of probation. The matter was adjourned to March 7, 2017 for sentencing and she was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

HERMAN J. HASSELL, age 47, of Nunda was sentenced on a conviction of Rape in the First Degree (B Felony) and Attempted Criminal Sexual Act in the First Degree (E Felony) as a second felony offender, to 10 years in state prison plus 20 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and Sexual Offender Registry Fees. An Order of Protection was issued for each of the victims.

ZACHARY W. HUNT, age 21, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 40 hours community service. He was ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution of \$673.38. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

TYSHAWN A. JONES, age 20, of Brooklyn was sentenced on a conviction of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Impersonation in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest, Criminal Possession of Marijuana in the Fifth Degree (B Misdemeanor), Speeding, and Unlicensed Operator, to 5 years in state prison plus 3 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay penalty assessments and a DNA fee.

ROBERT F. KRAUSE, JR., age 44, of Hemlock was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 64 hours community service. He was ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution of \$14,667.93.

TERRY J. MASSEY, age 52, of Cohocton was sentenced on a conviction of Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) to 6 months incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.

TIMOTHY A. MILLS, age 34, of Honeoye appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to January 17, 2017 for a hearing.

JOSEPH R. POLUCH, age 28, of Mumford pled guilty to Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor) and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017.

LUKE H. SWITZER, age 21, of Caledonia pled guilty to Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to February 21, 2017 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

GEORGIA S. THOMAS, age 41, of Geneseo was charged with Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Misuse of Food Stamps (E Felony). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 31, 2017.
