After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following case was handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on January 31, 2017.

SHAMON L. BEDELL, age 46, of Rochester was charged with Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Third Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Office in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Reckless Driving (Misdemeanor), and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 2, 2017 to appear with an attorney.

COLLIN J. DAVIS, age 22, of Conesus was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 year incarceration in the Livingston County Jail.

DAWN N. DIPILATO, age 34, of Honeoye appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to February 7, 2017.

STACEY M. EARL, age 31, of Auburn, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 11, 2017.

NICHOLAS R. FINCH, age 38, of Dansville was charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 28, 2017. Bail was set at \$25,000.

CHASE J. FRANCIS-WHIPSET, age 27, of Caledonia, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding, appeared without an attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 21, 2017.

JESSICA L. GOODENOW, age 35, of Nunda was sentenced on a violation of probation to continue probation with the addition of Livingston County Drug Treatment Court.

JAYMAR GRIFFIN, age 45, of Dansville pled guilty to Sexual Offender Failure to Register or Verify (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to February 6, 2017 for sentencing.

JAMES W. LEARN, age 25, of Dalton pled guilty to Sexual Offender Failure to Register/Verify (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017 for sentencing.

TAHEED M. MOFFETT, age 32, of Rochester was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony), Forgery in the Second Degree (D Felony), Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), Criminal Impersonation in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 21, 2017. Bail continues at \$50,000.

ERICK A. SANTIAGO, age 33, of Geneseo was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay restitution, a \$50 DNA fee, and an Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

GEORGIA S. THOMAS , age 41, of Geneseo, charged with Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Misuse of Food Stamps (E Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 28, 2017.

CLARENCE O. WARD, age 48, of Dansville pled guilty to Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017 for sentencing.
