After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on February 9, 2017.

PARIS D. BELLFIELD, age 37, of Fulton was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 3 years probation plus restitution. He was also ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee.

STEPHEN A. GARDNER, age 48, of Lakeville, charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), and Offering a False Instrument for Filing (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 9, 2017.

MICHAEL G. GORTON, age 45, of Conesus, convicted of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 23, 2017.

JAVAN L. JAMISON, age 29, of Hornell, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree, appeared without his attorney and the matter was adjourned to Feb 23, 2017.

ROLAND JENNINGS, III. age 46, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1 ½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

KARIM A. LITTLE, age 25, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility was sentenced on a conviction of Promoting Prison Contraband in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to a 1 year conditional discharge. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

PEGGY M. MERRILL, age 34, of Geneseo, charged with Forgery in the Second Degree (D Felony), Identity Theft in the Second Degree (E Felony), and Theft of Services (Misdemeanor), appeared without an attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 9, 2017.

SHAWN M. NORMAN, age 51, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring.. He was also ordered to pay restitution, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device .

CALVIN R. PATRICK, age 35, of Mt. Morris, charged with 2 counts of Criminal Sexual Act in the First Degree (B Felony), Rape in the First Degree (B Felony), Aggravated Sexual Abuse in the Third Degree (D Felony), and 4 counts of Unlawful Imprisonment in the First Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 30, 2017.

NICHOLAS A. PERHAM, age 32, of Nunda was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) to 1 ½ years in state prison plus 1 year post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

KENNETH J. STAHL JR., age 28, of Hemlock, charged with two counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and Resisting Arrest, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 20, 2017.

DAWN M. WATSON, age 38, of Conesus, charged with Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree (E Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Misuse of Food Stamps (E Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 30, 2017.

JAMES P. WILSON, age 23, of Mt. Morris, charged with Strangulation in the Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony), Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 22, 2017 for hearings.
