After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on February 28, 2017.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER, charged with Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the Second Degree (E Felony), Sexual Misconduct (Misdemeanor), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 14, 2017.

NICHOLAS R. FINCH, age 38, of Dansville, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared without an attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2017.

JENNIFER KEYSAW, age 38, of Liberty, convicted of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017 for sentencing.

RACHEL L. KING, age 32, of Mt. Morris, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), three counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), Criminal Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument (Misdemeanor), and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to an unknown date.

JOHN W. LANDER, III., age 50, of Rochester was charged with Criminally Negligent Homicide (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 14, 2017. Bail was continued at \$2,000.

RAYMOND F. LEMAY, age 56, of Hemlock was sentenced on a conviction of Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) to time served (6 months incarceration) and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee plus restitution.

JUAN G. MARRERO, age 43, of Mt. Morris, was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 1 year incarceration. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and an Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER, charged with Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony), Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), and Making Graffiti (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2017.

KRISTY L. PEFFERS, age 38, of Leicester, charged with Grand Larceny in the Second Degree (C Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 16, 2017.

JANICE A. SMALT, age 68, of Bath was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (Misdemeanor), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Failure to Dim Headlights, Possession of an Alcoholic Beverage in a Motor Vehicle, and Operating Outside of Conditions. She was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 14, 2017. Her license was suspended pending prosecution.

GEORGIA S. THOMAS, age 41, of Geneseo, charged with Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Misuse of Food Stamps (E Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2017.
