After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on March 7, 2017.

LAURA A. ADAMSON, age 33, of Groveland, charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), and 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2017 for hearings.

AXEL M. BROOKS, age 29, formerly of the Livingston Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2017.

NICHOLAS R. FINCH, age 38, of Dansville, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 23, 2017.

STEPHEN GAGNON, age 22, of Dansville was charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 9, 2017.

AMIE M. GOMOLL, age 34, of Conesus was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison and on a violation of probation to 2 years in state prison plus 2 years post-release supervision. She was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. Her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

ROBERT B. WIEDRICK, age 43, of Dansville appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to March 14, 2017. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.
