After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on March 30, 2017.

KERIANN BARBARITZ, age 37, of Batavia was sentenced on a conviction of Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) to 5 years probation to include 128 hours community service. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

MICHAEL A. BELL, age 29, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony). to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

CALEB M. BINNERT, age 42, of Livonia was charged with Failure to Register or Verify Sex Offender (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 20, 2017.

ADAM J. BUCCI, age 31, of Conesus, charged with Aggravated Criminal Contempt (D Felony), Strangulation in the Second Degree (D Felony), Harassment in the Second Degree, and Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2017.

NICHOLAS M. DAVIS, age 34 was sentenced on a conviction of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony) to 5 years in state prison plus 5 years post-release supervision as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

STEPHEN A. GARDNER, age 49, of Lakeville was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

ORLANDO HERNANDEZ, age 43, of Rochester was sentenced on 2 counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony) to 7 years in state prison on each count plus 5 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

JOSHUA M. HOFFMAN, age 26, of Churchville pled guilty to Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 25, 2017 for sentencing.

DEBORAH L. JUDD, age 40, of Dansville was sentenced on a violation of probation to 6 months incarceration in the Livingston County Jail.

DAVID R. MARK, age 30, of Dansville pled guilty to Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) the matter was adjourned to May 25, 2017 for sentencing.

JOANNE ROBERTS, age 34, of Mt. Morris appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to April 6, 2017. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

DAVID J. WOLFANGER, age 64, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor) to 6 months incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.
