After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on April 27, 2017.

THOMAS J. BUTLER, age 63, of Perry was charged with Course of Sexual Conduct Against a Child in the Second Degree (D Felony), 5 counts of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree (D Felony), and 5 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to June 29, 2017.

JONATHAN A. CADY, age 26, of Leicester pled guilty to Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 4, 2017 for sentencing.

FELIPE R. FERNANDEZ, age 46, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RACHEL M. LAUKO, age 22, of Mt. Morris appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to May 11, 2017.

MARY A. NEVERETT, age 43, of Gates, charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony) and Tampering with Physical Evidence (E Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 11, 2017. Bail continues at \$500,000.

AYKUT M. OZKAYNAK, age 35, of Gate, charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony) and Tampering with Physical Evidence (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 11, 2017. Bail continues at \$500,000.

CHRISTOPHER R. THOMPSON, age 30, of Honeoye Falls entered an admission to a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to June 29, 2017 for sentencing.

JAMES P. WILSON, age 23, of Mt. Morris, charged with Strangulation in the Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony), Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 4, 2017.
