**After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on May 18, 2017.**

**ANDREW J. BERNARD**, age 29, of Caledonia, convicted of Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor) and Attempted Tampering with Physical Evidence (Misdemeanor) appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 25, 2017 for sentencing.

**BRIAN K. COMSTOCK**, age 32, of Cohocton was charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Failure to Keep Right. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to June 29, 2017.

**KENNETH R. KIEHLE**, age 42, of Dansville appeared on a violation of intermittent sentence and the matter was adjourned for further proceedings.

**CARLOS O'NEAL**, age 27, formerly of the Groveland Correctional Facility was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) to 1½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

**THOMAS H. TROGE**, age 21, of Oyster Bay, charged with 4 counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), 2 counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) and 3 counts of Criminal Sale of Marihuana in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 14, 2017.

**EDWARD W. VADNEY**, age 32, of Springwater was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

**DUSTIN L. WHEELER**, age 22, of Dansville was charged with 2 counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony). He was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 25, 2017.
