After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on August 10, 2017.

JAMES J. BELKNAP, age 48, of Rush, charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 16, 2017 for trial.

THOMAS J. BUTLER, age 63, of Perry, charged with Course of Sexual Conduct Against a Child in the Second Degree (D Felony), 5 counts of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree (D Felony), and 5 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 17, 2017.

JASON R. EICHAS, age 46, of Livonia, charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Speeding, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 12, 2017.

AUDRA L. KAYS, age 35, of Springwater as sentenced on a conviction of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor) to 1 years incarceration. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

FRANKIE M. KNIGHTON, age 37, of Buffalo was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring and 128 hours community service. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. Her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

JACOB KOMARISKY, age 33, of Spencer was charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Crossing Hazardous Markings. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 7, 2017. His license was suspended pending prosecution.

RYAN W. LAJUETTE, age 32, of Rochester was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 5, 2017.

RICHARD P. LEE, age 43, of Caledonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

OWEN R. LOWRY, age 30, of Geneseo was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 6 months incarceration and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.
