After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following case was handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on December 8, 2016.

GENE A. BROWN, JR., age 38, of Rochester was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 22, 2016.

JEVON T. HEY, age 33, of Painted Post, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor) and Operating a Motor Vehicle with No Side Mirror, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 2, 2017.

ALBERT P. KNORR, age 41, of Belfast pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor) and the matter was adjourned to February 2, 2017. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

MATTHEW K. SACKETT, age 22, of Springwater was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor) to 3 years probation. He was also ordered to pay surcharges and DNA fees.

WENDY TEETER, age 43, of Dansville appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to December 15, 2016. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JAMES P. WILSON, age 23, of Mt. Morris was charged with Strangulation in the Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony), Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 5, 2017. Bail was set at \$7,500 and an Order of Protection was issued for the victim.
