After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following case was handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on October 18, 2016.

ANDREW J. BELL age 40, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony) as a second felony offender, to 5 years in state prison plus 3 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and his license was suspended.

ANDREW L. CAMPBELL, age 26, of Dansville, charged with Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), two counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and a violation of probation, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 1, 2016.

NICOLE B.I. ETHRIDGE, age 34, of Dansville, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 1, 2016 for hearings.

RENE M. FIGUEROA, age 48, of Mt. Morris, charged with Attempted Gang Assault in the First Degree (C Felony) and Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 22, 2016.

JABIN M. HUTTON, age 30, of Lima was sentenced on a conviction of Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 6 months in the Livingston County Jail and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

ARTHUR C. MCBRIDE, age 49, of Rochester was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 29, 2016.

RYAN P. MOSHER, age 24, of Mt. Morris pled guilty to Forgery in the Second Degree (D Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), and Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor), and the matter was adjourned to November 22, 2016. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JOSEPH R. POLUCH, age 27, of Mumford, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Refusal to Submit to a Field Screening Test and Failure to Keep Right, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 1, 2016.

EDGARDO SANTIAGO, age 36, of Mt. Morris, charged with Attempted Gang Assault in the First Degree (C Felony) and Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 22, 2016.

ERICK A. SANTIAGO, age 33, of Geneseo, charged with Attempted Gang Assault in the First Degree (C Felony) and Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 22, 2016.

DAVID J. STEINMETZ, age 34, of Springwater was sentenced on a conviction of Sexual Offender Failure to Register/Verify (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

LUKE H. SWITZER, age 20, of Caledonia was charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and Identity Theft in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 20, 2016.

GREGORY K. WALSH, age 26, of Geneseo, charged with Vehicular Assault in the First Degree (D Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor), Driving While Impaired by Drugs and Alcohol (Misdemeanor), Failure to Maintain Lane, and a violation of probation, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 1, 2016.
