After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on October 13, 2016.

FRANK J. CHRISTIANO, age 56, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) to 2 to 4 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

MICHAEL J. DANN, JR., age 28, of Dansville was charged with Sexual Offender Failure to Register or Verify (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 27, 2016.

JASON A. KLINKBEIL, age 28, of Livonia, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor), Driving While Impaired by Drugs and Alcohol (Misdemeanor), two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), and Criminal Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 20, 2016.

JOHN C. KRAUSE, age 46, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree (D Felony) to 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge.

BRUCE A. KELLISON, age 48, of Leroy was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and Harassment in the Second Degree to time-served and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim and his license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device .

ROBERT C. KENDALL, age 33, of North Rose was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign, Improper U-Turn, and Possession of an Alcoholic Beverage in a Motor Vehicle.

DELDRICK L. HOLLOWAY, age 37, of Elmira, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), Criminal Impersonation in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), and Unauthorized Sticker or Poster on Motor Vehicle, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016.

TYLOR E. PARSONS, age 20, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

SHANE M. SHAFFER, age 27, of Perry, was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

JULIE K. WOOD, age 26, of Mt. Morris, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and No Seatbelt, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 16, 2016 for hearings.
