After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on September 29, 2016.

JAYSON M. ARENA, age 41, of Leicester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$1,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

ANGEL M. COLON, age 41, of Mt. Morris appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to October 20, 2016.

STEPHEN A. GARDNER, age 48, of Lakeville, charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), and Offering a False Instrument for Filing (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016.

LESTER HOPE, age 20, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016. Bail was set at \$5,000.

TIFFANY L. ZAMBRANA, age 20, of Conesus appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to October 27, 2016.

JEFFREY A. MURPHY, age 32, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor) to time-served and 3 years probation plus restitution. (September 28, 2016)
