After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on September 15, 2016.

ALEJANDRO A. FIGUEROA, age 19, of Lima was charged with Possessing an Obscene Sexual Performance by a Child (E Felony) and Possessing a Sexual Performance by a Child (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016. Bail was continued at \$1,500.

BRANDON GEERY, age 23, of Caledonia admitted a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016.

CASSANDRA N. GROSS, age 22, of Dansville, charged with two counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony) and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 22, 2016. Bail was continued at \$1,500.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree (D Felony) to 6 months in the Livingston County Jail and 5 years probation.

JEVON T. HEY, age 33, of Painted Post was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor) and Operating a Motor Vehicle with No Side Mirror. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 8, 2016.

LESLIE M. JACKSON, age 54, of Piffard was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

CHAD N. MALONE, age 34, of Springwater was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and a violation of probation to 1 year in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

TERRY S. MATHEWS, age 26, of Bloomfield was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Suspended Registration, Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Failure to Keep Right. He was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 27, 2016.

MARY A. NEVERETT, age 43, of Gates was charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 13, 2016. Bail was set at \$500,000.

AYKUT M. OZKAYNAK, age 35, of Gates was charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 17, 2016. Bail was set at \$500,000.

WESLEY A. NELSON, age 42, of Bath pled guilty to Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to November 10, 2016.

MATTHEW K. SACKETT, age 21, of Springwater, charged with two counts of Rape in the Third Degree (E Felony), Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 13, 2016.

JULIE K. WOOD, age 26, of Mt. Morris, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and No Seatbelt, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 13, 2016.
