After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the Livingston County Grand Jury handed up indictments on the following individuals on September 14, 2016.

MARY A. NEVERETT, age 43, of Gates was charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony).

AYKUT M. OZKAYNAK, age 35, of Gates was charged with Murder in the Second Degree (A-1 Felony).

TERRY S. MATHEWS, age 26, of Bloomfield was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Suspended Registration, Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Failure to Keep Right.

ROBERT C. KENDALL, age 33, of North Rose was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign, Improper U-Turn, and Possession of an Alcoholic Beverage in a Motor Vehicle.

JOHN M. COLON, age 27, of Rochester was charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor).
