**After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following case was handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on August 23, 2016.**

**A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER** was sentenced on a conviction of Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the Second Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and an Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

**ANDREW J. BELL** age 40, of Rochester pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 18, 2016. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

**DAVIN M. L. BONNER**, age 24, of Mt. Morris, charged with Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 6, 2016. Bail was continued at \$25,000.

**ERIC R. BRUMSTED**, age 54, of East Bethany, charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Failure to Stop Sign at a Stop Sign, and No Plate Lamp, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned for further proceedings.

**NAPOLEAN S. BRYAN**, age 23 of Dansville, charged with Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 13, 2016. Bail was continued at \$10,000.

**DAWN N. DIPILATO**, age 34, of Honeoye, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 30, 2016. Bail was continued at \$2500.

**LEE A. GRIFFIN**, age 49, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 13, 2016.

**JABIN M. HUTTON**, age 29, of Lima was charged with Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) and Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor.) He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 18, 2016. Bail was set at \$2,000.

**TIMOTHY A. MILLS**, age 34, of Honeoye, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 30, 2016. Bail was continued at \$2,000.

**TIMOTHY J. PASSAGE**, age 32, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor) and Promoting Prison Contraband in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned for a trial date.

**JOSEPH R. POLUCH**, age 27, of Mumford, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Refusal to Submit to a Field Screening Test and Failure to Keep Right, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 4, 2016.

**FRANK SANTANA**, age 25, of Rochester, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 27, 2016.

**ANTHONY C. VELASQUEZ**, age 28, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) to 4 years' in state prison as a second felony offender plus 3 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution. His license was suspended.
