**After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on August 4, 2016.**

**A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER** was charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony) and Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor.) He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 13, 2016.

**JAYSON M. ARENA**, age 41, of Leicester was charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony.) He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 15, 2016.

**RODGER BRISCOE**, age 32, of Springwater was arraigned on a violation of probation, entered a denial, and the matter was adjourned to September 1, 2016. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

**FRANK CHRISTIANO**, age 56, of Mt. Morris pled guilty to Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 13, 2016 for sentencing.

**STEPHEN A. GARDNER**, age 48, of Lakeville, charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), and Offering a False Instrument for Filing (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 8, 2016.

**BLAYNE C. IPPOLITO**, age 20, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

**KATHERINE L. KURTZ**, age 57, of Wayland was sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

**WESLEY A. NELSON**, age 42, of Bath was charged with Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor.) He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 1, 2016. Bail was set at \$5,000.

**JOSEPH A. PALMA**, age 30, of Rushford appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to September 8, 2016. He was remanded without bail.

**JOHN H. PRIBBLE**, age 40, of Nunda was sentenced on a conviction of Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree (D Felony) to 2½ to 5 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

**MATTHEW K. SACKETT**, age 22, of Springwater, charged with two counts of Rape in the Third Degree (E Felony), Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 15, 2016.

**ROBERTO SANTOS**, age 32, of Rochester, charged with Forgery in the Second Degree (D Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 8, 2016.

**CRYSTAL D. SOPOROWSKI**, age 37, of Addison, charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor), Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), and Failure to Stay in Lane, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 1, 2016. Bail was set at \$5,000.

**JULIE K. WOOD**, age 26, of Mt. Morris, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), and No Seatbelt, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 13, 2016.
