After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on October 12, 2017.

JAMES J. BELKNAP, age 48, of Rush, pled guilty to Driving While Ability Impaired by Alcohol and was ordered to pay a \$300 fine, a \$255 surcharge, and his license was suspended.

ANN MARIE BOUDREAU, age 31, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor) and Criminal Possession of a Hypodermic Instrument (Misdemeanor) to time served. She was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

JASON R. EICHAS, age 46, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) to 16 weekends incarceration and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring. He was also ordered to pay a \$2500 fine, a \$520 surcharge, and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

ELBERT JACKSON, JR., age 55, of Rochester was charged with two counts of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 9, 2017.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 16 weekends incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

JOSEPH M. SPRING, JR., age 42, of Dansville pled guilty to Failure to Register or Verify Sex Offender (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to December 21, 2017 for sentencing.

JEFFREY J. WALKER, JR., age 21, of Livonia was charged with Criminal Disposal of a Weapon (D Felony) and two counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 9, 2017.

AMANDA S. WILSON, age 35, of Lakeville, charged with Promoting a Sexual Performance by a Child (D Felony), Possessing an Obscene Sexual Performance by a Child (E Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 9, 2017.
