After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on November 21, 2017.

ANTHONY P. BLAVESCIUNAS, age 47, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 2 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.

DELBERT R. CAPLINGER, JR., age 61, of Delevan was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 12, 2017.

JOSEPH R. CUOZZO, III., age 35, of York, previously sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) to 3 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation, was re-sentenced to 4 months intermittent incarceration (without work release) and to continue probation.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER, charged with Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the Second Degree (E Felony), 2 counts of Sexual Misconduct (Misdemeanor), and Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 12, 2017.

STEVEN W. GREGORY, age 27, of Kendall was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.

TERRY J. MASSEY, age 52, of Cohocton appeared on a probation matter and probation was modified to include 6 months electronic home monitoring.

CHAD D. MATTISON, age 41, of Dansville, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Ability Impaired (Misdemeanor), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 12, 2017.

RYAN C. MCCOLLUMN, age 36, of Livonia was sentenced on a violation of probation to continue probation with the addition of Drug Treatment Court.

LANCE A. RILEY, age 38, of Dansville was charged with Rape in the Second Degree (D Felony), 4 counts of Rape in the Third Degree (E Felony), Criminal Sexual Act in the Third Degree (E Felony), Incest in the Second Degree (D Felony), 3 counts of Incest Third Degree (E Felony), and 4 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 2, 2018. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

JAMEHR D. SMALL, age 21, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 9, 2017. Bail was set at \$5000.
