After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on November 30, 2017.

JOHN T. ALLEN, II., age 45, of Fulton, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), and Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 20, 2017 for hearings.

MARLIN L. CASH, age 38, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

DANIEL J. CIERI, age 57, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and Menacing in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to 5 year probation to include drug treatment court. He was also ordered to pay a \$1,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge, and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

SHARON L. DAVIS, age 54, of Geneseo, charged with Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (D Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony), and Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign, appeared without her attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 14, 2017. Bail was continued at \$200,000.

KRISTIAN P. GORDON-SMITH, age 31, of Geneseo was sentenced on a conviction of Sex Offender Failure to Register or Verify (D Felony) to 1 ¾ to 5 ¼ years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RYAN W. LAJUETTE, age 32, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to 2 months intermittent incarceration. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge.

ELBERT JACKSON, JR., age 55, of Rochester, charged with two counts of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 11, 2018.

ZE HAO LIN, age 22, of Brooklyn, charged with Criminal Possession of Marihuana in the Second Degree (D Felony) and Conspiracy in the Fifth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 7, 2017.

MARY A. NEVERETT, age 44, of Gates was sentenced on a conviction of Manslaughter in the First Degree (B Felony) to 19 years in state prison plus 5 years post-release supervision. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

DEVON O. RICHARDSON, age 39, of Rochester, charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Inadequate Tail Lights, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 4, 2018.

DAVID A. SHARPE, age 49, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

VIKTOR ZDOROVITSEV, age 65, of British Columbia was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 30 days in jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,500 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.
