After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on December 12, 2017.

DELBERT R. CAPLINGER, JR., age 61, of Delevan, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 9, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the Second Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation with sex offender conditions. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and an 8 year order of protection was issued for the victim.

ZACHARY J. FOLTS, age 34, of Wayland appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to January 2, 2018. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JANELLE JONES, age 26, of Livonia appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to January 9, 2018.

TERRY J. MASSEY, age 52, of Cohocton was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 year in the Livingston County Jail.

CHAD D. MATTISON, age 41, of Dansville, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Ability Impaired (Misdemeanor), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 20, 2018.
