After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on January 9, 2018.

JASMINE ADORNO, age 36, of Bronx, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 16, 2018.

DELBERT R. CAPLINGER, JR., age 61, of Delevan, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned for hearings.

ANTHONY CASSATA, age 53, of Dansville was charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 23, 2018. Bail was set at \$25,000.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

JANELLE M. JONES, age 26, of Livonia appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to February 27, 2018.

BALDEMAR MALDONADO, age 40, of Batavia was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to a conditional discharge and ordered to pay restitution plus a \$50 DNA fee. An Order of Protection was also issued for the victim.

JUSTIN D. MERKEL, age 32, of Geneseo was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor) to 4 months intermittent incarceration. He was also ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution.

ADAM R. PETERSON, age 36, of Livonia, charged with Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony), Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), and Harassment in the Second Degree, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 20, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was charged with Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) and 3 counts of Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 13, 2018.

NICHOLAS R. YOUNG, age 23, of West Sparta, charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony), Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), and Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 16, 2018.

JASON L. ZIENKIEWICZ, age 33, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 3 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.
