After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on March 8, 2018.

JOHN T. ALLEN, II., age 46, of Fulton, pled guilty to Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 10, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

KASSIE L. BRAZIEL, age 31, of Wayland was sentenced on a violation of probation to continue probation with the addition of Drug Treatment Court.

CORY A. CURRY, age 27, of Nunda was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

ASHLEY K. GRAUMANN, age 35, of Avon was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood ((Misdemeanor) to 128 hours community service and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring. She was also ordered to pay a \$1000 fine, a \$520 surcharge, and a \$50 DNA fee. Her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

JACOB A. HICKS, age 37, of Portage pled guilty to Arson in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 10, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JASON B. KORTS, age 41, of Webster was charged with Attempted Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the First Degree (C Felony) and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 24, 2018. Bail was continued at \$10,000 and an Order of Protection was issue for the victim.

DEVON O. RICHARDSON, age 39, of Rochester, convicted of Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 29, 2018.

KEVIN RIGDON, age 32, of Dansville pled guilty to Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 10, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

ROBERT L. ROGERS, age 46, of Rochester pled guilty to Attempted Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (C Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 10, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

BROOKE S. WAGNER, age 22, of Conesus was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor) to time served and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring. She was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.
