After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on March 13, 2018.

JAMES BALTAZAR, age 28, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility was charged with Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 24, 2018.

RICHARD P. BROWN, age 28, of Mt. Morris was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) and 2 counts of Criminal Possession of a Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 8, 2018. Bail was set at \$5000.

JENNIFER R. DEAN, age 30, of Dansville, charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Failure to Keep Right, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 20, 2018.

LAWRENCE R. HAPKE, age 54, of Rochester appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to March 20, 2018. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

SUSAN E. KING, age 43, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (E Felony) to 1½ years in state prison plus 2 years post-release supervision as a second felony offender.

DAVID A. LARGE, age 46, of Fairport was sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and Scheme to Defraud in the First Degree (E Felony) to 2 to 6 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

MATTHEW MCCLOSKEY, age 28, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

LANCE A. RILEY, age 38, of Dansville, charged with Rape in the Second Degree (D Felony), 4 counts of Rape in the Third Degree (E Felony), Criminal Sexual Act in the Third Degree (E Felony), Incest in the Second Degree (D Felony), 3 counts of Incest Third Degree (E Felony), and 4 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 20, 2018.

ANTHONY J. L. SMITH, age 28, of Dansville was charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony) and Petit Larceny. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 24, 2018.
