After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on March 20, 2018.

JASMINE ADORNO, age 36, of Bronx was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

JENNIFER R. DEAN, age 30, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. She was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. Her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

DANIEL J. FERRARO-GIBBS, age 35, of Spencerport was charged with Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 24, 2018. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

LAWRENCE R. HAPKE, age 54, of Rochester was sentenced on a violation of probation to time-served plus 100 hours community service and to continue probation.

BRUCE D. NEWTON, age 39, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree (D Felony) to 3 to 6 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution. An Order of Protection was issued for the victims.

ADAM R. PETERSON, age 36, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to 3 years probation to include 120 hours community service. He was also order to pay surcharges and a \$50 DNA fee. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

JAMIE T. SMITH, age 38, of Rochester was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and Unlawful Possession of Marijuana. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 1, 2018.

ALAN J. STEFANI, age 23, of Pennsylvania was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 1, 2018.
