After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on April 19, 2018.

DEREK J. GETMAN, age 27, of Conesus, charged with Predatory Sexual Assault against a Child (A Felony), Criminal Sexual Act in the First Degree (B Felony), Incest in the First Degree (B Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 20, 2018.

TIMOTHY GREEN, JR., age 29, of Rochester, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), and Unlawful Possession Marijuana, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to July 12, 2018.

MARJORIE A. HAZLETT, age 66, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Arson in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 9 months incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

DURUNE L. HILL, age 39, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 9 months incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

RACHEL M. LAUKO, age 23, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

DENNY OLMEDA, age 42, formerly of the Livingston Correctional Facility was charged with Aggravated Harassment of Employee by Inmate (E Felony.) He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 17, 2018.

EUGENE N. SMITH, age 69, of Rochester was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident, and Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 17, 2018.

DAWN M. WATSON, age 39, of Conesus, charged with Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree (E Felony), Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony), Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Misuse of Food Stamps (E Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 14, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was arraigned on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to May 9, 2018 for a hearing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

SARAH L. BARNES, age 22, of Bath was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor.) She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 12, 2018.

JEFREY TERRY, age 36, of Nunda was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (D Felony), Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Failure to Signal, and Consumption of Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 17, 2018. Bail was set at \$5000.
