After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on May 22, 2018.

BARBARA A. ADAMS, age 51, of Dansville was charged with Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony) and Conspiracy in the Fifth Degree (Misdemeanor). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 3, 2018.

DANIEL J. FERRARO-GIBBS, age 35, of Spencerport pled guilty to Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to August 14, 2018 for sentencing.

REBECCA A. GARRISON, age 28, of Dansville was charged with Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (E Felony) and Conspiracy in the Fifth Degree (Misdemeanor). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to June 5, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to May 29, 2018 for a hearing.
