After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on June 14, 2018.

ROBERT T. BENTLEY, age 29, of Wayland was charged with Forgery in the Second Degree (D Felony) and Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 26, 2018.

RICKY E. BUTTON, age 40, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, pled guilty to Promoting Prison Contraband in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and the matter was adjourned to September 6, 2018 for sentencing.

ELFIN ELLIOTT, age 34, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, charged with Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to July 12, 2018. Bail was set at \$25,000.

WAYNE C. ENGLERT, age 58, of Dansville, charged with Sex Offender Failure to Register or Verify (E Felony) appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 15, 2018 for hearings.

CHRISTINE L. GOODMAN, age 46, of Geneva was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1 ½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

JEFFREY L. HAYES, age 53, of Henrietta was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust. He was arraigned without an attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 12, 2018.

ANDREA M. HOLLADA, age 44, of Livonia admitted a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to August 30, 2018 for sentencing. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

ROBERT HYDE, age 47, of Conesus admitted a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to September 6, 2018 for sentencing.

KEVIN W. LORKA, age 61, of Cheektowaga was charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony), 2 counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree (D Felony), and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 26, 2018. Bail was set at \$1,000.

MIKEN M. PALMER, age 35, of Livonia plead guilty to Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to September 20, 2018.

JAMES J. RIECHEL, age 41, of Leroy was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 6 months incarceration and 5 years probation to include electronic home monitoring. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

RYAN A. ROSS, age 21, of Bath was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor) to 8 months incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

DAWN M. WATSON, age 39, of Conesus was sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) to 11 months incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

KASCHEEN S. WILLIAMS, age 19, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) to 3 years in state prison plus 2 years post-release supervision. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution. His license was suspended.

SHANNON F. ZENNER, age 42, of Avon was charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Failure to Signal. She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 12, 2018. Her license was suspended pending prosecution.
