After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on July 24, 2018.

**BAILEE J. BORDEN**, age 22, of Nunda, charged with Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 7, 2018.

**ERICA CRESPO**, age 28, of Mt. Morris was charged with Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 7, 2018. Bail was set at \$2500.

**JOSE L. CRUZ SOTO**, age 39, of Mt. Morris was charged with 3 counts of Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and 3 counts of Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 7, 2018. Bail was set at \$10,000.

**JANELLE M. JONES**, age 27, of Livonia, charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), 20 counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and a violation of probation, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 7, 2018.

**MICHAEL A. MCMURTY, JR.**, age 23, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with 6 counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 4, 2018.

**JESSICA L. MEAD**, age 24, of Hornell pled guilty to Aggravated Driving While Impaired by Drugs with a Child (E Felony) and Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor) and the matter was adjourned to September 25, 2018.

**KENNETH T. MOUNTZOUROS**, age 60, of Conesus, charged with Sexual Abuse in the First Degree (D Felony), 2 counts of Forcible Touching (Misdemeanor), 2 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), and Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared without an attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 14, 2018.

**NATHAN K. MOUNTZOUROS**, age 35, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Impaired by Drugs (D Felony) to time served and 5 years probation to include Drug Treatment Court. He was also ordered to pay a \$2,000 fine, a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device and he was ordered to attend the DWI Victim Impact Panel.

**FRANK J. MULLEY**, age 54, of Leicester, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Refusal to Submit to Field Screening Device, and Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 21, 2018.

**A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER** pled guilty to Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to September 25, 2018 for sentencing.

**DONNA J. SHELTON**, age 44, of Wyoming pled guilty to Welfare Fraud in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 9, 2018.

**TERRANCE L. STANLEY**, age 28, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with 2 counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 4, 2018.

**ROBERT L. TURNER**, age 62, of Rochester was charged with Criminal Possession Forged Instrument in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 4, 2018.
