After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on July 26, 2018.

ROBERT T. BENTLEY, age 30, of Wayland pled guilty to Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 25, 2018 for sentencing.

CORY J. CHAPMAN, age 31, of Dansville was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

FREDERICK C. CHICHESTER, age 71, of Livonia was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Resisting Arrest, Unregistered Motor Vehicle, Uninspected Motor Vehicle, and Refusal to Submit to Field Screening Device. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 23, 2018.

ELFIN ELLIOTT, age 34, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility pled guilty to Attempted **Assault** in the Second Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to September 20, 2018 for sentencing.

REBECCA V. FLANAGAN, age 42, of Conesus, charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Unsafe Lane Change, and Consumption of Alcohol in Motor Vehicle, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to September 20, 2018.

JAMES M. HARPOLE, age 58, of Conesus was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and Refusal to Submit to Field Screening Device. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 30, 2018.

KIMBERLY J. HART, age 47, of Mt. Morris appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to August 16, 2018. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

DYLAN M. LEW, age 20, of Portageville pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to November 15, 2018.

KEVIN W. LORKA, age 61, of Cheektowaga was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree (D Felony) to time served (6 months) and 5 years probation.

JASON A. QUICK, age 35, of Nunda was charged with Criminal Possession Marihuana in the Third Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 30, 2018.

DARIEN M. RAFORTH, age 52, of Rochester was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speed in Zone. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 23, 2018.

HEATHER M. ROCK, age 41, of Dansville was sentenced on a violation of probation to 1 to 3 years in state prison.

EUGENE N. SMITH, age 69, of Rochester, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident, and Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 23, 2018.

JEFREY S. TERRY, age 36, of Nunda was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony) to 1 ½ to 4 ½ year in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

ULISES VALENTIN, age 43, of Mt. Morris was charged with 3 counts of Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and 3 counts of Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to August 16, 2018. Bail was set at \$ 15,000.

BRETT S. WEBSTER, age 26, of Pennsylvania was charged with Criminal Possession of a Firearm (E Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to September 20, 2018.

JONATHAN T. WELLS, age 23, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 29, 2018.
