**DA NEWSLETTER ~ AUGUST 21, 2018**

After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on August 21, 2018.

**ADAM J. FUETTERER**, age 33, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) to time served and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and his license was suspended.

**JOSHUA A. GANG**, age 35, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018.

**ANN MARIE HIGHSMITH**, age 40, of Rochester pled guilty to Attempted Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (C Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 16, 2018 for sentencing.

**A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER** was charged with Criminal Possession of Marihuana in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 16, 2018.

**A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER** was charged with Making a Terroristic Threat (D Felony) and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to October 16, 2018.

**JANELLE M. JONES**, age 27, of Livonia pled guilty to Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018 for sentencing.

**LOIS L. MARK**, age 55, of Prattsburgh was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Contempt in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1 ½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

**DAWN M. WILSON**, age 53, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree (Misdemeanor) to 3 years probation. She was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.
