ROBIN J. CAMPBELL, age 56, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. She was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee. Her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

TODD J. DALE, age 41, of Dansville was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 6, 2018.

ERIC C. HARDER, age 36, of Leicester, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 25, 2018.

WILLIAM LOPEZ, age 44, of Rochester pled guilty to Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to December 6, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JEFFREY C. PATTERSON, age 28, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

JASON C. TORREGROSSA, age 44, of York was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest, and Reckless Driving. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to December 6, 2018. Bail was set at \$25,000.
