DA NEWSLETTER ~ OCTOBER 16, 2018

After presentation by District Attorney Gregory J. McCaffrey and First Assistant District Attorney Victor D. Rowcliffe, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on October 16, 2018.

DANIELLE M. ALLEN, age 23, of Livonia was sentenced to three to nine years in state prison after a jury found her guilty of Manslaughter in the Second Degree (C Felony). She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

BAILEE J. BORDEN, age 22, of Nunda, charged with Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 30, 2018.

CHRISTOPHER W. CAMPBELL, age 37, of Mt. Morris pled guilty to Criminal Sale Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and the matter was adjourned to December 18, 2018 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

ANTHONY CASSATA, age 54, of Dansville, convicted of Attempted Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018 for sentencing.

ARTHUR E. COLES, age 28, of Canandaigua was charged with Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Resisting Arrest, and Throwing Refuse on Highway. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 20, 2018.

KIMBERLY L. DELAVERGNE, age 43, of Mt. Morris, charged with Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fifth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned for possible hearings.

STEPHEN GAGNON, age 23, of Dansville appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER, charged with Making a Terroristic Threat (D Felony), Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), and Falsely Reporting an Incident in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018.

ANN MARIE HIGHSMITH, age 40, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (C Felony) to 6 months incarceration and 5 years probation. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and her license was suspended.

WAYNE G. JOHNSON, age 34, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) to time-served and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution. His license was revoked.

LANNY L. JONES, age 34, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to 2 months intermittent incarceration. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge.

ANGEL E. LOPEZ, age 18, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of Marihuana in the Second Degree (D Felony) to time-served and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

RICHARD A. METCALF, age 53, of Dansville, charged with Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018.

STEVEN P. RIGONI, age 39, of Pavilion, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to October 30, 2018.

KAYANA A. SALMON, age 23, of Rochester, charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property Third Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), Driving While Impaired by Drugs (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (E Felony), Criminal Impersonation in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Reckless Driving, 2 counts of Speeding, and 2 counts of Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign, appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 20, 2018 for hearings.

SHAWN D. SEMPLE, age 37, of Hornell, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to December 18, 2018.

DAVID M. SKINNER, age 57, of Livonia, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned for possible hearings.

RODNEY R. SPARROW, age 50, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 27, 2018.
