DA NEWSLETTER ~ OCTOBER 30, 2018

After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on October 30, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to November 20, 2018.

BAILEE J. BORDEN, age 22, of Nunda pled guilty to Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and the matter was adjourned for further proceedings.

ANTHONY CASSATA, age 54, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (E Felony) to 1 ½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

STEPHEN R. GAGNON, age 23, of Dansville appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to November 20, 2018. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JOSHUA A. GANG, age 35, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 27, 2018.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Making a Terroristic Threat (E Felony) to five years probation to include 120 hours community service. He was also ordered to pay \$100 restitution.

JANELLE M. JONES, age 27, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony) and a violation of probation to four months intermittent incarceration and five years probation. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and restitution.

PAUL E. LATONE, age 63, of Conesus was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), Failure to Signal Turn, and Failure to Maintain Lane. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 27, 2018. His license was suspended pending prosecution.

ROBERT J. MILLER, age 47, of Pennsylvania was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Speeding, and No Seatbelt. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 27, 2018.

COREY R. MOSS, age 32, of Hemlock pled guilty to Sex Offender Failure to Register or Verify (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to January 7, 2019 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

SHERYL A. PALERMO, age 51, of Tonawanda, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony), 2 counts of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), 2 counts of Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), and 2 counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 7, 2019.

RYAN PRIVETTS, age 30, of Elmira was charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 7, 2019.

STEVEN P. RIGONI, age 39, of Pavilion, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 7, 2018.

ZULEIKA RIOS-RIOS, age 37, of Rochester pled guilty to Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in Her Blood (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to January 7, 2019 for sentencing.

KEVIN SARAUW, age 23, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 27, 2018.

ANTHONY J. SMITH, age 28, of Dansville, convicted of Petit Larceny, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 20, 2018.

JAMES K. SMITH, JR, age 33, of Rochester, pled guilty to Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to January 14, 2019.

MICHAEL G. SWICK, age 29, of Mt. Morris, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 8, 2018. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JAMES A. THADDIES, age 41, of Elmira was charged with Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and two counts of Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to November 8, 2018.

ROBERT L. TURNER, age 62, of Rochester, charged with Criminal Possession Forged Instrument in the Second Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to November 19, 2018 for hearings. Bail was continued at \$10,000.
