DA NEWSLETTER ~ DECEMBER 13, 2018

After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on December 13, 2018.

TODD J. DALE, age 41, of Dansville was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and his license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

ERIC C. HARDER, age 36, of Leicester pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to February 7, 2019 for sentencing.

TIMOTHY H. HARRINGTON, age 44, of Dansville pled guilty to Criminal Purchase of a Weapon (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to February 7, 2019 for sentencing.

CHRISTOPHER J. MATUSAK, age 35, of Henrietta was sentenced on a conviction of Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 2 to 4 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

DAVID A. PFUNTER, age 65, of Dansville, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 31, 2019 for hearings.

MICHAEL G. SWICK, age 29, of Mt. Morris, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 24, 2019.
