DA NEWSLETTER – JANUARY 15, 2019

After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on January 15, 2019.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to March 12, 2019. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

JOHN T. AREND, JR., age 19, of Avon was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), and Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 12, 2019.

JOSEPH I. BLIZZARD, age 32, of Dansville, charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree (C Felony), Criminal Sale of a Firearm in the Third Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession of a Firearm (E Felony), and Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 29, 2019.

TAILEK E. FLETCHER, age 19, of Syracuse was charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), and Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 19, 2019. Bail was set at \$25,000.

PAUL E. LATONE, age 64, of Conesus, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Unsafe Lane Change, and Failure to Signal, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 19, 2019 for hearings.

BURT T. LYON, JR., age 53, of Conesus was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Impaired by Drugs (E Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor) to one to three years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$2000 fine, a \$520 penalty assessment, and a \$50 DNA fee. His license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

SHERYL A. PALERMO, age 51, of Tonawanda, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony), two counts of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated with a Child (E Felony), two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), and two counts of Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with her attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 29, 2019.

WILLIAM W. PRITCHARD, age 38, of Canaseraga, charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (Misdemeanor), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 26, 2019.

DYLAN J. ROBBINS, age 27, of Pennsylvania, charged with two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Possession Weapon in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), and Inadequate Exhaust, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to January 17, 2019.

JASON R. SAVOY, age 37, of Lima was sentenced on a conviction of Sexual Offender Failure to Register or Verify (D Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RAYMOND L. SCOTT, age 46, of Dansville was charged with Sexual Offender Failure to Register or Verify (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 29, 2019.

SHAWN D. SEMPLE, age 37, of Hornell was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) to 2 months intermittent incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$500 fine and an \$85 surcharge.

NICK J. WILLIAMS, age 36, of Leicester, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), and Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 5, 2019 for hearings.
