DA NEWSLETTER – JANUARY 17, 2019

After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on January 17, 2019.

SANDRA N. BROWN, age 41, of North Carolina pled guilty to Menacing a Police Officer (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to April 18, 2019 for sentencing. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

LUIS COLLAZO-NEGRON, age 28, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration in the Livingston County Jail and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

ALEXANDER M. GRAVESANDY, age 32, of Rochester pled guilty to Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and the matter was adjourned to April 18, 2019 for sentencing.

LEWIS E. HENRY, JR., age 46, of Mt. Morris was charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), and Failure to Keep Right. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 24, 2019. His license was suspended pending prosecution.

MARK A. LAPAGLIA, age 53, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) to four months intermittent incarceration in the Livingston County Jail and five years probation to include electronic home monitoring. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and his license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

RICARDO SANTANA, age 26, of Mt. Morris was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Ability Impaired by the Combined Influence of Drugs or of Alcohol and any Drug or Drugs (Misdemeanor), and Leaving the Scene of a Property Damage Accident. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to January 31, 2019. His license was suspended pending prosecution.

TYRIK STYLES, age 30, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 14, 2019.

RAYMOND H. WALTER, JR, age 60, of Avon was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to February 7, 2019.

EVYN A. ZENNER, age 22, of Avon was sentenced on a conviction of Burglary in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 1 to 3 years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and \$520 restitution. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.
