DA NEWSLETTER – JANUARY 31, 2019

After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on January 31, 2019.

BENJAMIN B. GRESSINGER, age 25, of Perry was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree (D Felony) to 4 months intermittent incarceration and 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

CELYMAR LOPEZ CARRION, age 25, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) to 3 years in state prison plus 2 year post-release supervision. She was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

CHARLES MACK, age 47, of Rochester was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2019.

TODD J. MILLIMAN, age 48, of Wayland was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Criminal Possession Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (C Felony) to 5 years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

DAVID OTERO, age 31, of Springwater, charged with Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony) and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to February 14, 2019.

NITASHIA L. ROBB, age 27, of Bath pled guilty to Tampering with Physical Evidence (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2019 for sentencing. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail.

AKEEM L. ROBINSON, age 30, of Rochester, charged with two counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2019 for hearings.

ARON SMITH, age 48, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility pled guilty to Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to April 18, 2019 for sentencing.

JASON C. TORREGROSSA, age 44, of York pled guilty to Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest, and Reckless Driving and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2019 for sentencing.

PETER VONDERHOFEN, age 26, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility, charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to March 7, 2019.
