DA NEWSLETTER – FEBRUARY 28, 2019

After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on February 28, 2019.

KEVIN E. DOLISON, age 23, of Geneseo was charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2019. Bail was set at \$25,000.

MICHAEL F. DONOVAN, age 28, of Livonia pled guilty to Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to April 25, 2019 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

CANDACE ELLIS, age 33, of Conesus was charged with three counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), two counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor). She was arraigned with her attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 18, 2019. Bail was set at \$25,000.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER pled guilty to Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to April 25, 2019 for sentencing.

SAMUEL S. GARRISON, age 44, of Nunda was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree (E Felony) to time-served and four years probation. He was also order to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

LEWIS E. HENRY, JR., age 46, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) to four months intermittent incarceration in the Livingston County Jail and five years probation to include electronic home monitoring. He was also ordered to pay a \$520 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and his license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

JEAN M. LEVEY, age 61, of Lakeville was arraigned on a Violation of Probation and the matter was adjourned to March 14, 2019.

LEO F. SCHLEDORN, age 30, of Dansville was charged with three counts of Predatory Sexual Assault Against a Child (A Felony) and Use of a Child in a Sexual Performance (C Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2019.

VERNARDO V. TAITE, age 35, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2019.
