After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the Livingston County Grand Jury handed up indictments on the following individuals on February 20, 2019.

ZACHERY A. BISHOP, age 20, of Piffard was charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor).

KEVIN E. DOLISON, age 23, of Geneseo was charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor).

ADAM J. KENYON, age 32, of Tonawanda was charged with Criminal Possession of Marijuana Second Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession Controlled Substance Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Possession Marijuana, and Insufficient Tail Lamps

TERRY L. STEWART, age 39, of Springwater was charged with two counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Speeding, Failure to Comply, Failure to Signal, No Seatbelt, and Refusal to Submit to a Field Screening Test.

CHRISTOPHER S. POZZI, age 38, of Lindley was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (D Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Operating a Motor Vehicle without an Ignition Interlock Device (Misdemeanor), Driving on Shoulder of the Roadway, and Refusal to Submit to Field Screening Device.

LEO F. SCHLEDORN, age 30, of Dansville was charged with three counts of Predatory Sexual Assault Against a Child (A Felony) and Use of a Child in a Sexual Performance (C Felony).

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was charged with Rape in the Second Degree (D Felony).
