DA NEWSLETTER – MARCH 14, 2019

After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on March 14, 2019.

ANNE AGUIRRE, age 48, of Livonia was sentenced on a conviction of Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor) to 128 hours community service and three years' probation to include electronic home monitoring. She was also ordered to pay a \$1000 fine, a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and her license was revoked with a requirement to install an Ignition Interlock Device.

AMBER ELLIS, age 32, of Nunda appeared on a Violation of Probation and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2019. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

SCOTT T. FIOREDELISO, age 28, of Webster was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the First Degree (E Felony) to four months intermittent incarceration and five years probation to include NYS Sex Offender Registration. He was also order to pay a \$325 surcharge, a \$50 DNA fee, and a \$1,000 sex offender fee.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER pled guilty to Attempted Robbery in the Third Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019 for sentencing.

ALEXANDER M. GRAVESANDY, age 32, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor) and Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor) to one year in the Livingston County Jail. He was also order to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

ROBERT HOMER, age 37, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility pled guilty to Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019 for sentencing.

JEAN M. LEVEY, age 61, of Lakeville appeared on a Violation of Probation and the matter was adjourned to March 28, 2019.

BRADLEE R. REDMAN, age 26, of Dansville, charged with Rape in the Second Degree (D Felony) and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (A Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 4, 2019.

AKEEM L. ROBINSON, age 30, of Rochester was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) to three years in state prison plus three years post-release supervision as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RONALD ROBINSON, age 62, of Syracuse was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to time-served and five years probation. He was also order to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RICARDO SANTANA, age 26, of Mt. Morris pled guilty to Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Driving While Ability Impaired by the Combined Influence of Drugs or of Alcohol and any Drug or Drugs (Misdemeanor), and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019 for sentencing.

STEVEN D. STEFANO, age 41, of Piffard, convicted of Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 20, 2019 for sentencing.

TERRY L. STEWART, age 39, of Springwater was charged with two counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Speeding, Failure to Comply, Failure to Signal, No Seatbelt, and Refusal to Submit to a Field Screening Test. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 18, 2019.

FREDDIE J. TAYLOR, age 50, of Rochester was charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Grand Larceny in the Third Degree (D Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), two counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Assault in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Reckless Driving, and two counts of Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 25, 2019. Bail was set at \$20,000.

JASON C. TORREGROSSA, age 44, of York was sentenced on a conviction of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree (Misdemeanor), Unlawful Fleeing a Police Officer in the Third Degree (Misdemeanor), Resisting Arrest, and Reckless Driving to a term of one to three years in state prison. He was also ordered to pay a \$300 fine, a \$325 surcharge, and a \$50 DNA fee.

PETER VONDERHOFEN, age 26, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility pled guilty to Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony), and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019 for sentencing.

MICHAEL A. WALTON, age 49, of Geneseo, charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and Speeding, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 25, 2019.
