DA NEWSLETTER – MARCH 19, 2019

After presentation by Gregory J. McCaffrey, District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on March 19, 2019.

CARLOS DIAZ-SILVA, age 35, of Mt. Morris, charged with two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and two counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to April 30, 2019.

KRISTOPHER H. EDELMAN, age 28, of Rochester, charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the Third Degree (misdemeanor), and Speeding, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 21, 2019.

CHARLES R. ENGEL, age 48, of Philadelphia was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 23, 2019.

CIRILO HERNANDEZ, age 38, of Hornell was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony) and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to April 23, 2019.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to April 23, 2019.

ERIC VAN CUREN, age 36, of Dansville appeared on a violation of probation and the matter was adjourned to March 27, 2019. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

ALPHONSO L. BOUIE, JR., age 24, of Rochester pled guilty to Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to June 4, 2019 for sentencing.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was charged with Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 21, 2019.
