DA NEWSLETTER – APRIL 18, 2019

After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on April 18, 2019.

ZACHERY A. BISHOP, age 20, of Piffard, charged with Robbery in the First Degree (B Felony), four counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), three counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 23, 2019. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

TERRANCE B. BEDELL, age 33, of Rochester, charged with two counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019.

KEVIN E. DOLISON, age 23, of Geneseo, charged with two counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 2, 2019. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

AMBER ELLIS, age 32, of Nunda appeared on a Violation of Probation and the matter was adjourned to April 25, 2019. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

CANDACE ELLIS, age 33, of Conesus pled guilty to Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to June 20, 2019 for sentencing. She was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail. An Order of Protection was issued for the victim.

OWEN R. LOWERY, age 31, of Groveland was charged with Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 23, 2019. He also appeared on a Violation of Probation and was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

BRADLEY D. MYERS, age 25, of Perry was charged with Burglary in the Second Degree (C Felony), Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), six counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (misdemeanor), Improperly Displayed License Plate, and Inadequate Plate Lamp. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to May 16, 2019.

DAVID OTERO, age 31, of Springwater was sentenced on a conviction of Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor) to one year incarceration in the Livingston County Jail. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 penalty assessment and a \$50 DNA fee.

TERRY L. STEWART, age 39, of Springwater, charged with two counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Speeding, Failure to Comply, Failure to Signal, No Seatbelt, and Refusal to Submit to a Field Screening Test, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to May 2, 2019.

MICHELLE E. VAZQUEZ-COSME, age 37, of Mt. Morris was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony) to time-served and five years probation. She was also order to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

RAYMOND H. WALTER, JR, age 60, of Avon pled guilty to Reckless Driving and was ordered to pay a \$1,000 fine and a \$200 surcharge.
