DA NEWSLETTER – MAY 7, 2019

After presentation by Joshua J. Tonra, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on May 7, 2019.

PATRICK A. DUNN, age 28, of Geneseo was charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Failure to Keep Right, and Failure to Yield the Right of Way to an Emergency Vehicle. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 2, 2019. His license was suspended pending prosecution.

MARK C. HARRINGTON, age 51, of Livonia, charged with six counts of Predatory Sexual Assault Against a Child (Class A-II Felony), Sexual Abuse in the First Degree (D Felony), and Attempted Criminal Sexual Act in the First Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned for hearings.

HIPOLITO J. ROMAN, JR., age 39, of Rochester, charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 25, 2019.

STEPHEN L. SMYDER, age 51, of Wayland was sentenced on a conviction of Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor) to four months intermittent incarceration and three years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$50 DNA fee and restitution.

PHILLIP J. SNYDER, age 31, of Lima was charged with Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving with .08 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony), Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), Failure to Stop Sign at a Stop Sign, and Speeding. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to July 2, 2019.

MICHAEL T. SULKOWSKI, age 27, of Dansville, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony), Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (C Felony), and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 4, 2019.
