DA NEWSLETTER – MAY 23, 2019

After presentation by Victor D. Rowcliffe, First Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Dennis S. Cohen on May 23, 2019.

TERRANCE B. BEDELL, age 33, of Rochester pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (B Felony) and the matter was adjourned to August 8, 2019 for sentencing.

ZACHERY A. BISHOP, age 20, of Piffard, charged with Robbery in the First Degree (B Felony), four counts of Robbery in the Second Degree (C Felony), three counts of Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony), two counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (E Felony), Petit Larceny (Misdemeanor), and Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 20, 2019.

LOGAN J. BRITTON, age 27, of Hemlock was sentenced on a conviction of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (Misdemeanor) to three years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$200 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

GENE A. BROWN, age 41, of Rochester was charged with Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony), two counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree (E Felony), Operating a Motor Vehicle with Inadequate Headlights, and Following Too Closely. He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to June 13, 2019.

ELIJAH K. DAVIS, age 22, of Rochester pled guilty to Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the First Degree (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to June 13, 2019. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

A YOUTHFUL OFFENDER was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Robbery in the Third Degree (D Felony) to five years probation with time-served and 60 hours community service. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge.

OWEN R. LOWERY, age 31, of Groveland, charged with Assault in the Second Degree (D Felony) and a violation of probation, appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 13, 2019.

ANTONIO R. MASEDA, age 20, of New York City, charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (D Felony), and Criminal Sale of Marihuana in the Fourth Degree (Misdemeanor), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to August 8, 2019.

BRADLEY D. MYERS, age 25, of Perry was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree (D Felony) to time-served and five years probation to include Drug Treatment Court. He was also ordered to pay restitution.

CHRISTOPHER E. SPICER, age 44, formerly of Livingston Correctional Facility was charged with Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (D Felony). He was arraigned with his attorney, pled not guilty, and the matter was adjourned to June 20, 2019.

TYRIK STYLES, age 30, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony) to 1½ to 3 years in state prison as a second felony offender. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

VERNARDO V. TAITE, age 35, formerly of Groveland Correctional Facility, convicted of Attempted Promoting Prison Contraband in the First Degree (E Felony), appeared with his attorney and the matter was adjourned to June 20, 2019.
