DA NEWSLETTER – AUGUST 6, 2019

After presentation by Justin M. Hill, Assistant District Attorney, the following cases were handled in the Livingston County Court before the Honorable Robert B. Wiggins on August 6, 2019.

PATRICK A. DUNN, age 28, of Geneseo pled guilty to Driving While Intoxicated (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to September 10, 2019.

ADAM J. KENYON, age 33, of Tonawanda was sentenced on a conviction of Attempted Criminal Possession of Marijuana Second Degree (E Felony) to five years probation. He was also ordered to pay a \$325 surcharge and a \$50 DNA fee.

ANGEL E. LOPEZ, age 19, of Pennsylvania was sentenced on a violation of probation to one year in the Livingston County Jail.

RUSSELL H. MAURER, age 63, of Livonia appeared on a Violation of Probation and the matter was adjourned to August 27, 2019. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

DEVIN M. SCHUMACHER, age 18, of Dansville pled guilty to Disseminating Indecent Material to Minors in the First Degree (D Felony) and the matter was adjourned to October 15, 2019 for sentencing. He was remanded to the Livingston County Jail without bail.

PHILLIP J. SNYDER, age 32, of Lima pled guilty to Aggravated Driving with .18 of One Percent or More of Alcohol in His Blood (E Felony) and the matter was adjourned to August 27, 2019.
