LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2020 LOCAL LAW APPLYING THE SALARY REVISIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. 2019-450 TO ALL COUNTY OFFICERS SERVING FOR FIXED TERMS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT AND FINDINGS

The Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines that the salaries of County Officer's serving for fixed terms of office may be changed and adjusted only by local law.
